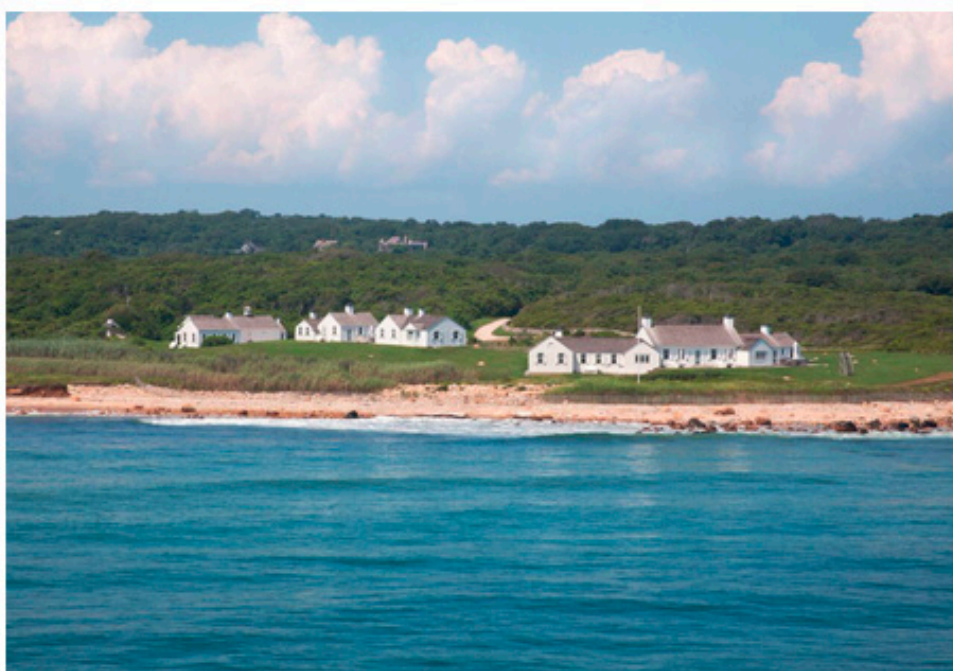




Top 5 - Hamptons Homes With Celebrity History

Back in 1971, pop artist Andy Warhol purchased a less than grand 5.7 acre estate, once owned by the Church family, who famously made their fortune from Arm & Hammer baking soda products, for \$225,000. He filled the home with his rock star friends Mick Jagger and Keith Richards of the “Rolling Stones” as well as luminaries like Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis and Elizabeth Taylor. In 2007, Mickey Drexler, CEO of J. Crew, purchased the property for \$27M and began extensive renovations under the watchful eye of architect Thierry Despont. Back on the market as of June 2015, the compound that includes the nearby 24-acre equestrian property, with the best views on The End, features 6 cottages, two restored barns with 29 stalls, and 4 acres that can be converted from pasture to a swimming pool and tennis area.
