

Grand Victorian in Peconic: North Fork Dream Home

Traditional meets top-of-the-line in this 4,000-square-foot Victorian with Old World ambience. Impressively sited on just shy of two acres in the heart of Long Island wine country, its aesthetic is a rare find on the North Fork.

"It is very regal," said listing agent Nicole LaBella of Town & Country Real Estate. "It is not a typical North Fork style home with cedar planking. It is more like a palace."

The custom-built home was constructed in 2004 with exquisite craftsmanship and attention to detail. Travel up the long private driveway to meticulously maintained gardens and you'll immediately be taken by the traditional architecture with large front porch.

The large entryway outfitted luxe marble floors and a grand staircase welcomes guests into opulence. The first floor boasts a large open floor plan that includes a state-of-the-art kitchen with a large granite island and Brazilian cherry floors.

"It is palatial," LaBella said. "Everything was custom made. The interior has a traditional look with top-of-the-line appliances."

The four-bedroom, four-bathroom home features a spacious master suite with a marble bath in the ensuite and walk in closets. The third floor of the home also offers spectacular water views.

A private beach with a boat ramp is just second away from the estate.

"It has so much to offer," LaBella said. "There is nothing else like it on the North Fork."

The home is listed for \$1,450,000.
