

North Fork Dream Home: Thoughtfully Renovated Circa 1840 Colonial

Owning an original North Fork home is special, owning one that's been stunningly renovated and restored is even better. Enter this week's Dream Home: a circa 1840 traditional colonial set on 1.30 acres in Laurel.

The home, known as the Reeve-McNulty House, was originally owned by prominent farming families, and now features upscale modern amenities without comprising the home's original details and character.

"This home is quite unique to the North Fork sales market. Most historic homes that have been on the market are not in the best condition and require renovation. This offering is like a showhouse exuding grace and character," listing agent Kate Carpluk of Town & Country Real Estate told us. "The current owners have a fabulous eye for design and outfitting this whole house anew. It is a very handsome home."



The renovated kitchen is a must-see outfitted with Viking professional stainless appliances, custom KraftMaid cabinetry, quartz countertops, a wine fridge, and impeccable style. From there, a Butler's Pantry, an oversized laundry room with a Pro GE washer and dryer, a mud room, and an office complete the home's additions.



On the main level, you'll also find four oversized connecting rooms in the original front section of the home including a family room, a formal living room or parlor, a music room, a formal dining room, and a full bathroom.

A prominent original central staircase leads you upstairs to four spacious bedrooms and a full bathroom.

"The sprawling, level 1.3-acre property is lush with majestic

trees and a quaint outbuilding that can be a pool house or garden house. There's also plenty of room for any size pool," added Carpluk.

The property is listed at \$949,500.
